

Dunblane Town Centre Charrette – Update 1st June 2015

Why did we carry out this project?

To provide an opportunity for the local community to set the future agenda for Dunblane Town Centre.

How many people participated in the Charrette process?

Including responses to the Pre-charrette Survey held in March, the community engagement numbers totalled 463. However some people took several opportunities to participate and therefore the number of individuals involved is less than that figure suggests.

Where are we at the moment?

The 4 day Charrette events generated 97 ideas for further consideration. These are all currently undergoing a careful “reality” review by Planning Aid Scotland and the Project Steering Group to assess how they could:

- Help create a 10 – 20 year vision for our town centre
- Inform the development of realistic community actions that are achievable over the next 5 years

What happens next?

- A Charrette report and draft Community Action Plan to be available by 6th July
- Further Community engagement during July/August
- Final Community Action Plan to be published by 1st September
