6	<ul> <li>Planning The Main Issues Report for the new Local Development Plan has been produced, and the public has until 30 July to respond to this. The Holmehill group is acknowledged in the report, and its wish to maintain the hill as open space [MIR Ref DUNB06]. Stirling Council suggests approval for affordable housing on some of the land it owns [gifted by Grace Donaldson] [MIR Ref DUNB02]. It also seems to suggest approval for affordable housing on a small part of the land owned by Allanwater Developments, by the Perth Road [MIR Ref DUNB05]. A lengthy wide-ranging discussion took place, generally welcoming the MIR, but expressing concern of the impact of any housing on the hill.
