Generous grants are available to help with the maintenance of trees. 5	<p>Stirling Council Draft Proposed Local Development Plan This has been published and there is to be an additional period of consultation until 16 December before a Proposed LDP is published next year. There will be a drop-in session at Braeport on 18 November to question Council officers. CS summarised details of the document with particular reference to Holmehill and Bogside. Generally the proposed plan is favourable. It recognises Holmehill as ‘a prominent natural landmark [which] creates a green heart to the centre of the town and wooded backdrop in many views’. No building is proposed on the part of Holmehill currently owned by Allanwater Developments. There is a proposal for the building of 10 ‘units’ on Bogside, on Council-owned land. It was agreed we should respond before 16 December. CS letter of 30 July 2011 is still valid, but should be redrafted to respond to the Draft Proposed LDP.
