- 3. <u>Unauthorised tree felling and re-planting order</u>. Chris Toop re-capped. Spraying, burning and tree-felling continues. The Council has served a Re-planting Order. The landowner has not complied within the time limit. The Council can now replant and bill the landowner. We need to watch, photograph, record and keep pressure on the Council to do this. There was discussion about other ways we could ensure the replanting occurs. We will liaise with Mark Ruskell [after the Referendum].
- DP will write to the Tree Officer to ask about spraying of Willow and replanting.
- Alan Booth advised the he had an email from the Access Officer, stating it is acceptable to
  open the fencing, as a gate, provided no damage is done. He will forward this to the
  Community Police.

- Alan Booth suggested a Bat survey. Any tree-felling of trees in which bats are roosting would be illegal. It was agreed to contact the Bat Conservation Trust for advice
