Stirling Council is holding an Open Day and Conference for private landlords at Stirling's Albert Hall on Tuesday 13th May.

The event is an opportunity for landlords and agents to meet key players in the Private Rented Sector in Stirling, to gather information and to seek advice.

Head of Housing in Stirling, Tony Cain, said: "We have speakers from the Scottish Association of Landlords and the National Landlords Association who will be talking about all the recent changes in legislation, regulation and guidance, which have made being a landlord something of a minefield.

"I would encourage all local private landlords, and anyone thinking about becoming a private landlord in the area, to attend."

Various agencies and services will attend the Open Day to provide expert information and guidance. They include the Landlord Registration Team, representatives of tenancy deposit schemes, advice on energy efficiency, the Scottish Fire and Rescue Service, and a number of different Council Services.

The Conference will take place in the afternoon from 2pm to 5pm and in the evening from 6pm to 9pm. Speakers include Homes for Good (afternoon), Shelter (evening), the National Landlords Association, the Scottish Association of Landlords and Landlord Accreditation Scotland.
