**The Stirling Council Tree Preservation Order (No. 1) 2014 (Holme Hill, Perth Road, Dunblane)**

Please find enclosed a copy of the above Tree Preservation Order (TPO) recently made by Stirling Council together with a copy of the plan accompanying the TPO.

The TPO is sent to you as an interested person in terms of Regulation 4(1)(b) of the Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and Trees in Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 2010.

The Council considers that the TPO is necessary as the woodland is historically and visually significant to Dunblane, its Cathedral and historic town centre, and of high amenity value within the Dunblane Conservation Area

Any person may make representations about or objections to the making of the TPO. If you wish to make such representations or objections, you should do so in writing and send them no later than 12 December 2014 to the Chief Planning Officer, Stirling Council, Municipal Buildings, 8-10 Corn Exchange Road, Stirling stating the nature and grounds of your representations or objections.

The Council must consider any such representations or objections made in accordance with the above Regulations. Having considered those representations or objections, the Council may decide either not to confirm the TPO or to confirm the TPO with or without modification.

The Council will write to you again when a decision has been made on whether to confirm the TPO.
