From autumn 2017 new electric trains will begin running across the central belt.

This means more seats and shorter journey times for our customers.

For this to happen, we need to upgrade the tunnel that leads to and from Glasgow Queen Street **High Level** station.

The tunnel will **close for 20 weeks** while we complete this work.

Journeys will take longer during the closure, as trains will be diverted to either **Queen St Low Level or Glasgow Central**.
