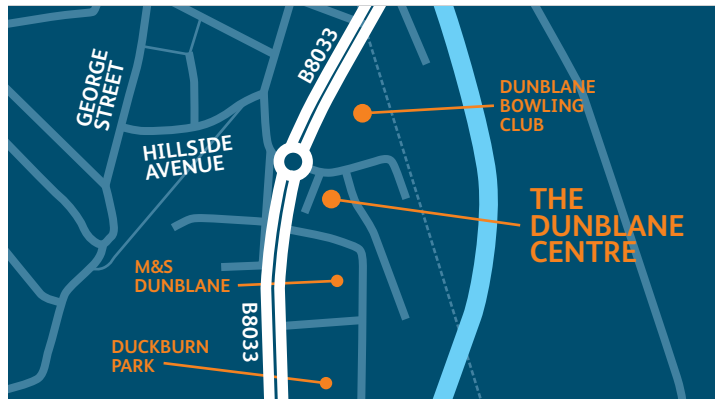


Network Rail Community Drop-in

As part of a Scottish Government investment in our infrastructure, Network Rail is delivering work to electrify the railway across central Scotland - including Grangemouth and Falkirk through Stirling to Dunblane and Alloa, which will enable, longer, faster, quieter, cleaner and greener modern electric trains.

The next phase of works, between Kippenross Tunnel and Dunblane Station, will involve piling foundations in to the ground to provide the base for the overhead masts.

Before the piling work starts we are hosting a community drop-in event, where members of the public can come along and meet the project team to ask any questions and discuss the work.
