Dear Mr Hynes,

As Member of the Scottish Parliament for Clackmannanshire and Dunblane, I have been contacted by constituents with concerns over proposed new timetables serving the Dunblane and Bridge of Allan train stations.

My constituents are concerned that the new timetable will see only 2 services to Edinburgh between 7am and 8 am versus 4 at the moment, and that in the evening the service will be reduced from three trains between 5pm and 6pm to two. In addition, some services which currently run direct between these stops will now requires a change in Stirling.

Could you explain the rationale for the changes, and for the apparent reduction in services, and indicate if there are plans to increase the number of directly connected services and reduce travelling times as new rail stock is introduced following electrification?

I am grateful for your assistance with this matter, and look forward to your response in due course.
