

Claredon Place

The COUNCIL made The Stirling Council (Claredon Place, Dunblane) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic, Suspension of Parking and Suspension of One-Way System) and (Sunnyside, Dunblane) (Temporary Suspension of One-Way System – No 2) Order 2025 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) on 25-7-25.

The ORDER will close:-Claredon Place From its junction with the B8033 to its junction with Hillside Avenue

The ORDER will also suspend the parking on:-

- Claredon Place On the east side on the road from its junction with Hillside Avenue in a southerly direction for a distance of 50 metres or thereby, and;

On the west side on the road from its junction with George Street in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 20 metres or thereby
- George Street On the north side on the road from its junction with Claredon Place in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 20 metres or thereby.

The ORDER will also suspend the one-way system on:-

- Claredon Place From its junction with the B8033 to its junction with the section of road that leads to John R Gray Road.
- Sunnyside For its entire length from 22-8-25 until 23-8-25 to facilitate public utility works. Emergency Service access will be maintained.

Alternative Routes: via B8033, Sunnyside, Claredon Place and vice versa.

This Order will close a

Kilbryde Crescent From its north-westerly junction with Doune Road to its junction with Auchinlay Road from 25-8-25 until 31-8-25 to facilitate public utility works.

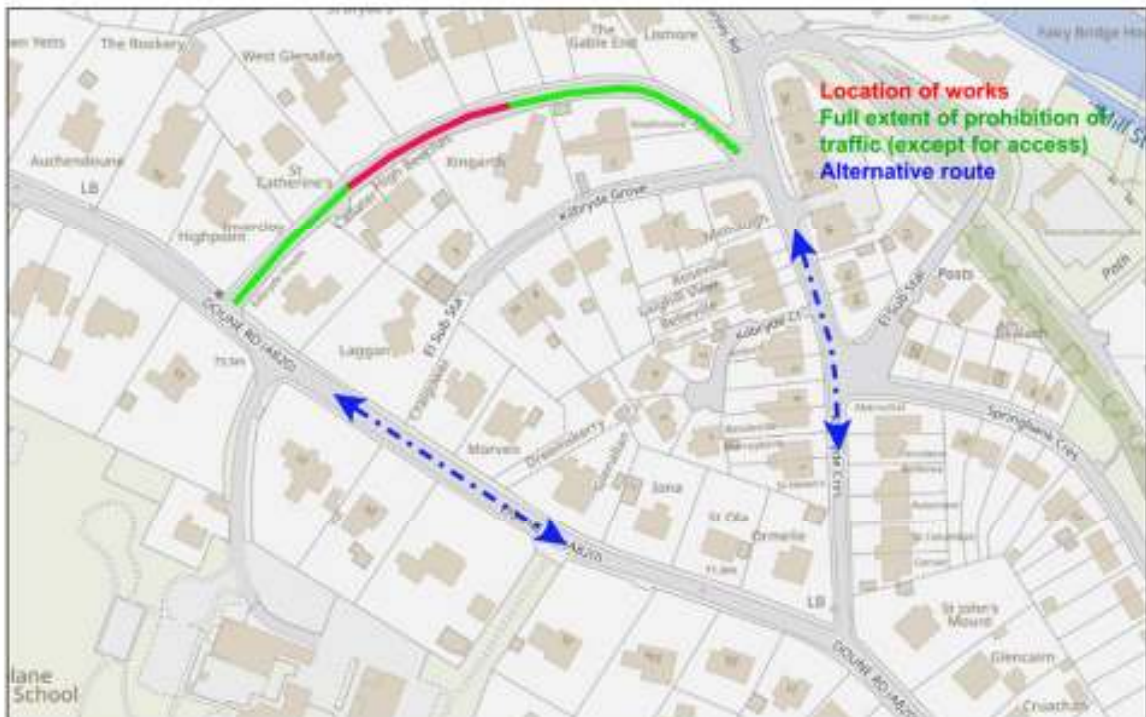
Emergency service access will be maintained

Prohibition of Traffic - Kilbryde Crescent, Dunblane

The COUNCIL made The Stirling Council (Argyle Way, Dunblane) (Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians) Order 2025 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) on 25-7-25.

This Order will close the following footway:

Argyle Way From the north-western boundary of No 45 to the north-western boundary of No 32 (including the cul-de-sac), from 0800 hours until 1730 hours from 18-8-25 until 5-9-25 to ensure public safety during footway works.

Alternative Routes: n/a – works will be carried out in phases

The COUNCIL made The Stirling Council (B8033 Perth Road, Dunblane) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic and Suspension of Parking) and (Glen Road / High Street, Dunblane) (Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2025 under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) on 25-7-25.

This Order will close and suspend the parking on:

B8033 From its junction with Beech Road to the south-east side of Fourways Roundabout.

This Order will also close:-

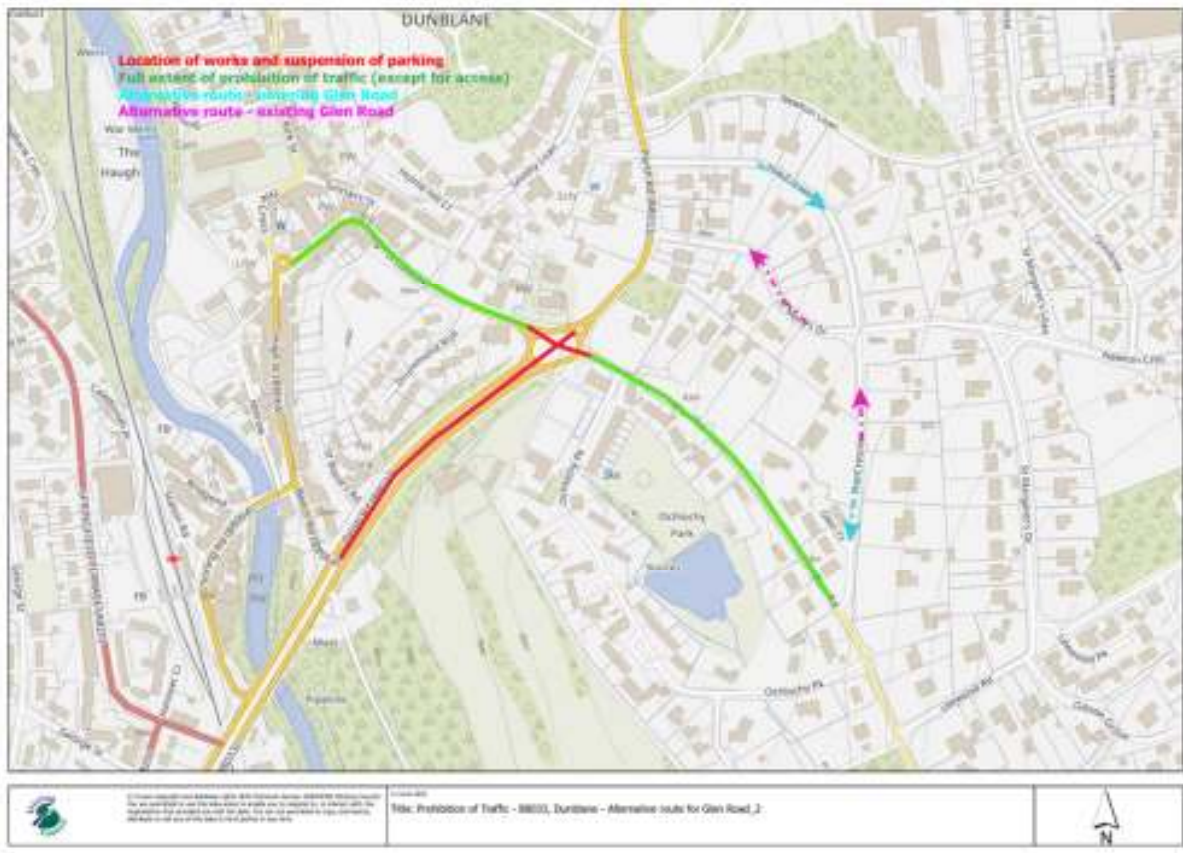
Glen Road From its junction with the B8033, Perth Road to its junction with The Crescent Cross.

High Street From its junction with the B8033, Perth Road to its junction with The Cross from 2100 hours until 0630 hours from 3-8-25 until 10-8-25 to facilitate road repair works.

Emergency service access will be maintained

Alternative Routes: B8033 - via B8033, A9, A820 and vice versa
Glen Road – via St Mary’s Drive (for traffic exiting Glen Road)
Glen Road – via The Crescent (for traffic entering Glen Road)
Cyclists and local access to The Haining via Beech Road, High Street, The Cross, Kirk Street
Cyclists and local access to Perth Road via High Street, Smithy Loan, Perth Road
